One of the great estates in Prosecco. A delightful, fresh, fruity sparkling wine. | 24.00 |
| 1. | Gardet Brut Tradition - Chigny-les-Roses
Altogether fresh, with a full-bodied consistency, fine acidity and a balance between creamy and bold. | 39.50 |
| 2. | Laurent Perrier Brut
45% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir and 15% Pinot Meunier. Delicate with hints of citrus fruit and great balance. | 55.00 |
| 8. | Bollinger Special Cuvee
Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. | 66.00 |
| 7. | Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut
A full bodied Champagne. Affectionately known as the Widow. | 65.00 |
| 5. | Louis Roederer Brut Premier
One of the few houses still owned by the same family since it was founded in 1776. | 68.00 |

One of the finest Rosé Champagne made. The colour comes from the skins of the Pinot Noir giving the wine fabulous strawberry and redcurrant nuances. | 75.00 |
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LIGHT & FRUITY WHITE WINES

Refreshing light easy drinking wines that contain no oak. These wines are perfect with fish or ideal as an aperitif.

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| 13. Rioja Blanco – Rioja Vega, Spain | 21.00 |
| The nose has aromas of conference pear, white flowers and some limey notes. Fresh, clean and crisp in the mouth with good length and balance. | |
| 14. Dart Valley Reserve – Sharpham Estate, Devon, England | 25.00 |
| Pale lemon colour, fruit aromas with hints of vanilla, ripe fruit with balanced acidity, a touch of residual sugar and a hint of oak. | |
| 15. Fiano Carlomagno – Puglia, Italy | 22.00 |
| Very full and intensely fruity on the nose with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit. | |
| 16. St Veran - Domaine Luquet, Burgundy, France | 26.00 |
| No oak used here, just pure, fresh varietal Chardonnay flavours.
Bags of ripe fruit with good acidity. This wine is quite outstanding! | |
| 17. Pinot Grigio - Amori, Veneto, Italy | 19.00 |
| A fresh and fruity wine, with a bouquet of tropical and citrus fruit, elegant and perfectly balanced on the palate. | |
| 18. Pouilly Fuissé 'Au Bourg' 2016 - Domaine Luquet, Burgundy, France | 36.00 |
| A wine of great purity, intense and tightly bound with notes of stone and mineral. The acidity is very good and will enable it to age well. | |

CRISP DRY AROMATIC WINES

Predominantly Sauvignon based wines but will also cover Riesling and steely Chardonnay such as Chablis. Again no oak ageing. These wines are totally dry (i.e. no residual sugar) and make great aperitifs or perfect with fish.

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| 23. Sauvignon Blanc - Le Charme, France | 19.00 |
| Overt bouquet with classical gooseberry pungency. Refreshing and quenching on the palate. | |
| 24. Pouilly Fumé 2017 - Chateau de Tracy, Loire, France | 39.50 |
| The aromas of boxwood and redcurrants on the nose follow through on the palate are complemented by aromas of fresh citrus fruit. Good length on the finish. | |
| 25. Chablis - Domaine des Marronniers, Burgundy | 29.00 |
| A classic, tightly knit wine with a steely backbone and overtones of apple and herb. Brilliantly racy on the finish. | |
| 26. Pouilly Fumé - Domaine Jean Pabiot, Loire, France | 29.50 |
| Jean Pabiot makes a great Pouilly Fume, bags of ripe, grassy asparagus fruit with a delicious gun flint overtone. | |
| 27. Sancerre - Domaine Sylvain Bailly, Loire, France | 31.00 |
| Classic Sancerre, crisp, fresh and full of mouthwatering opulent gooseberry fruit flavours. Beautifully restrained with all the subtle nuances that the region originally became famous for. | |
| 28. Chablis 1er Cru 'Montmains' 2013 - Domaine de Marronnieres, France | 35.00 |
| One of the finest 1er Crus offering unrivalled elegance, yet with the tightly knit structure that ensures excellent ageing potential - great vintage. | |
| 29. Sauvignon Blanc - Kuki, Marlborough, New Zealand | 25.00 |
| The grape that put New Zealand on the world wine map. Lovely crisp fresh gooseberry and grassy flavours that linger. Quite outstanding! | |
| 30. Sauvignon Blanc 2015/2016 - Cloudy Bay, New Zealand | 43.00 |
| What can I say other than "get in quick" as it sells very quickly. | |

FULL BODIED WHITE WINE

This section is predominantly oak aged Chardonnays. The oak gives the wine greater depth of flavour and richness. These are definitely food wines and can accompany light meats, such as chicken or veal. With lobster look no further than the Meursault from Michelot - Bin 34.

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| 31. Chassagne Montrachet Vieilles Vignes 2016 Domaine Amiot - Burgundy, France | 57.00 |
| Apple strudel bouquet, ripe, honeyed and intense. Full bodied, rich and 'thick' texture to the palate with flavours of roasted nuts, dry minerals and matching acidity. Great minerality and full toasty style. | |
| 32. Chardonnay – Les Argelières Marilyn Lasserre, IGP Pays d'Oc, France | 20.00 |
| Shimmering gold in the glass, aromas of ripe apples and dainty hints of vanilla and nuts with a buttery note. Dense and velvety on the palate but ever so fresh with a long finish. | |
| 34. Meursault 2011 - Domaine Michelot, Burgundy, France | 49.50 |
| This wine has nutty, toasty oak adding the depth and richness to the citrus, apple and melon fruit. | |
| 37. Pinot Gris - Domain Road, Central Otago, New Zealand | 31.00 |
| Beautifully expressive and fragrant, the inviting bouquet shows white nectarine, poached pear and floral characters. The palate delivers excellent concentration and focus, beautifully enhanced by silky texture and rounded mouthfeel. | |
| 38. Meursault "Clos St Felix" 2012 - Domaine Michelot, Burgundy, France | 50.00 |
| Domaine Michelot is one of the great Meursault domaines and Clos St Felix is a rather unique walled vineyard within their estate. The slightly warmer microclimate results in a particularly intense style of Meursault. | |

ROSÉ

Wines that can be drunk easily without food at any time of the day and can be served lightly chilled on a hot summers day. Perfect with chicken, white meats, pasta and fuller flavoured fish dishes.

42. **Côtes de Provence Henri Gaillard** - Côtes de Provence, France 25.00
Aromas of mouth-watering strawberries and raspberries. A well-balanced structure, full and fresh, with a lingering aromatic finish.
43. **“Bush Vine” Blush** - Richelieu, France 19.00
Clean, fresh finish. Made from Cinsault in the south of France.
44. **Sancerre Rosé** - Domaine Sylvain Bailey, Loire, France 29.50
Delicious flavours of wild flowers, delightfully quenching with ripe vibrant fruits.

SOFT & VELVETY REDS

Light to medium in weight, these wines have little in the way of tannic structure but compensate with bags of soft ripe berry fruit flavours.

46. **Montepulciano d’Abruzzo Noi Cento** - Roxan, Italy 20.00
Characteristic notes of mature red cherries on the palate and nose, tannins are soft and mature. Fresh and enjoyable red.
49. **Fleurie** - Domaine Pardon, Beaujolais 29.00
The epitome of Beaujolais – silky, sexy and racy!
50. **Merlot** - Le Charme, France 19.00
Ripe rich plum and damson fruit, soft and very moreish.
57. **Rioja Vega Tempranillo** - Rioja Vega, Spain 21.00
From the same producer as Bin 59. The Tempranillo has no oak ageing and is fresh and fruity from 90% Tempranillo and 10% Garnacha. Delicious drinking.
60. **Pinot Noir** - Kuki, New Zealand 31.00
Aromas of red berry, cherry spice with slight savoury notes. The palate shows bright cherry and brambly berry with firm tannins giving succulent length and suppleness.

REFINED MEDIUM BODIED REDS

More weight and depth here with the use of oak ageing playing a greater part. Elegant and balanced, these are great 'all-rounders' but especially good with cheese.

54. **Pigeolet des Brunier** - Vaucluse, Rhone 27.00
The Brunier in question is Daniel Brunier, owner and winemaker of the fabulous, Domaine Vieux Telegraphe. France at its best, rich, full of ripe black fruit flavours, soft tannins, long finish - great!
55. **Carignan Gran Reserva** - Alto Los Romeros, Maule Valley, Chile 24.00
Hints of violets combine with blackberries and raspberries and just a touch of cocoa to create a soft supple mid weight very approachable wine.
58. **Chateau Corbin** - Montagne St. Emilion, Bordeaux, France 27.50
Packed with ripe damson and plum flavours mixed with a little oak producing an easy drinking harmonious wine.
59. **Rioja Vega Crianza** - Bodegas Muerza, Spain 24.00
Magnificent concentration of ripe, moreish fruits, sturdy structure and beautifully weaved tannins. "Crianza" denotes the wine has been matured in oak for at least 6 months in addition to extra time in glass.
61. **Springhill Merlot** - Irvine Estate, Australia 24.50
On the nose there are raspberry and plum and the palate is medium-weighted with soft tannins and a chocolate edge on the finish. A great introduction to the Irvine portfolio.
64. **Shiraz** - Monastier, France 20.00
A cosy, soft red with rich fruit of blackberries, delicate spice and a hint of licorice, velvety tannins and a lovely structure. A real Frenchman with a slight down under accent!
65. **Château Moulin de Mallet** - Bordeaux, France 22.00
Very often inexpensive claret can be quite poor quality, but not this. Lovely ripe blackcurrant and plum flavoured wine. Nice rounded tannins with a good finish.
69. **Megaphone "Ventoux"** - F & D Brunier, Rhone 29.00
Frederic and Daniel Brunier are the owners / winemakers of Domaine Vieux Telegraph, one of the great Chateauneuf du Papes. This is a new wine from them made from 80% Grenache and 20% Syrah. Only 550 c/s were made and we were fortunate to secure a few. It has deep serious nose laced with liquorice and black fruits. Velvety smooth flavours linger on the palate. Quite delicious.

RICH, FULL BODIED RED

These are big full bodied wines. Deep rich flavours that really do need food to express their full potential. Ideal with Game or Red Meat dishes that have a strongly flavoured sauce.

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| 62. Shiraz Irvine Estate - Barossa, Australia | 35.00 |
| Winner of the 'Best 2016 Shiraz Trophy' at the 2017 Barossa Wine Show. Up against some of the most famous Shiraz producers in Australia this cooler climate Shiraz from Estate vineyards in the Eden Valley took the top honour. A vibrant crimson wine with aromas of ripe red cherry, blackberry and some hints of coffee. Fresh red fruit carries onto the palate, nicely balanced with fine tannins and a smooth finish. | |
| 66. Jonty's Duck - Avondale Estate, Paarl, South Africa
(Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec) | 29.00 |
| On the nose there is lots of blackcurrant and liquorice, with a hint of dark chocolate and ground coffee. The wine has an explosion of fruit on the palate and well integrated, elegant tannins to support it. | |
| 67. Primitivo Appassimento Carlomango - Puglia, Italy | 22.00 |
| The nose is complex with aromas of over-ripe cherries, raspberries, redcurrants, plum spices and chocolate. | |
| 70. Malbec 'Lunta' - Mendel, Argentina | 28.00 |
| Fabulous rich powerful blackcurrant and raspberry flavours with a touch of toasty vanilla – soft velvety tannins on the finish. Quite delicious! Mendel are without doubt one of Argentina's finest producers! | |
| 71. Crozes Hermitage "Cuvee L" 2014 - Domaine Combier, Rhone | 32.00 |
| Laurent Combier produces pure unadulterated concentrated Syrah that is farmed organically. 2014 was a lovely vintage in the Rhone as this wine is testament. We have featured several of Combiers Crozes Hermitage in the last 4/5 years, however for value for money this "Cuvee L" takes some beating. | |
| 74. Gandarada Boas Quintas - Dão, Portugal | 23.50 |
| Rich, full-bodied and rounded - seamless in style and with a core of sweet jammy red fruits. | |

FINE & RARE REDS

A little bit of bottle age giving great complexity and finesse.

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| 48. Volnay Domaine Lafarge 2010 - Burgundy, France | 56.00 |
| More perfumed than the Volnay villages and more seductive and creamy. With pure ripe red fruits and a sweet edge and rich core. Touch of liquorice - well integrated oak, hint of mulberry then the firmer tannins evolve from the glass. Long Opulent seductive - sexy! | |
| 53. Savigny les Beaune 'Vieilles Vignes' 2013 - Domaine Ecard, Burgundy | 45.00 |
| Lovely cherry and strawberry nuances, well rounded and a delicious finish. The wines of Michel Ecard have been a favourite of ours over the years so we were delighted to see he has now started his own domaine with his wife Joanna. | |
| 63. Vosne Romanee 2011 - Domaine Grivot, Burgundy | 69.00 |
| An aristocratic linear style with great purity of fruit and precision. Velvety and voluptuous, bags of strawberry fruits a superb tanninstructure and a fine, opulent finish. | |
| 72. Chateauneuf du Pape 2011 - Domaine Vieux Telegraphe, Rhone | 63.00 |
| "a sweet bouquet of spiced black cherries, plum, truffle, saddle leather and underbrush. Coming from tiny yields (which were down 50% from 2010), this medium to full-bodied 2011 is gorgeously textured and has solid mid-palate depth, terrific purity of fruit and ripe tannin. Relatively approachable and enjoyable even now, it should nevertheless evolve gracefully for 15-20 years." Jeb Dunnuck | |
| 73. Rioja Vega Gran Reserva 2012 - Rioja, Spain | 39.50 |
| Ruby red colour of medium intensity, clean and bright. Delicate and elegant balsamic aromas with well-integrated poasted hints. Soft and fine on the palate, with well balanced structure and a velvety texture. | |

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| 76. Pacherenc de Vic Bihl Collection - Plaimont, France (50cl) | 19.50 |
| The golden colour and sparkling tints of this wine give us a clue as to its rich, complex nose of preserved fruit (lemon peel), peach jam and white pepper. | |
| 77. Pocas Ruby Port - Douro Valley, Portugal | 25.00 |
| Very rich aromas of ripe young fruits. Strong and full-bodied, long and persistent finish. | |
| 78. Pocas LBV Port 2013 - Douro Valley, Portugal | 30.00 |
| Significant of ripe berry fruits. Full-bodied, yet elegant, with a very long mouth finish. | |
| 79. Pocas 10 Year Tawny Port - Douro Valley, Portugal | 35.00 |
| Woody bouquet of dried fruits and raisins. Fruity and well matched with the wood. Full-bodied, irresistible and complex, with a long lasting finish of dried plums. | |



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
