15. <b>Fiano Carlomagno - Puglia, Italy</b> Very full and intensely fruity on the nose with exotic fruit such as melon and banana, featuring hints of citrus reminiscent of grapefruit.	7.35	5.50
16. <b>St Veran - Domaine Luquet, Burgundy</b> No oak used here, just pure, fresh varietal Chardonnay flavours. Bags of ripe fruit with good acidity. This wine is quite outstanding!	8.70	6.55
17. <b>Pinot Grigio - Amori, Italy</b> A fresh and fruity wine, with a bouquet of tropical and citrus fruit, elegant and perfectly balanced on the palate.	6.35	4.75
23. <b>Sauvignon Blanc - Le Charme, France</b> Overt bouquet with classical gooseberry pungency. Refreshing and quenching on the palate.	6.35	4.75
25. <b>Chablis - Domaine des Marronniers, Burgundy</b> A classic, tightly knit wine with a steely backbone and overtones of apple and herb. Brilliantly racy on the finish.	9.70	7.30
27. <b>Sancerre - Domaine Sylvain Bailly, Loire</b> Classic Sancerre, crisp, fresh and full of mouth-watering opulent gooseberry fruit flavours. Beautifully restrained with all the subtle nuances that the region originally became famous for.	10.35	7.80
29. <b>Sauvignon Blanc - Kuki, New Zealand</b> The grape that put New Zealand on the world wine map. Lovely crisp fresh gooseberry and grassy flavours that linger. Quite outstanding!	8.35	6.30
32. <b>Chardonnay - Les Argelieres, France</b> Shimmering gold in the glass, aromas of ripe apples and dainty hints of vanilla and nuts with a buttery note. Dense and velvety on the palate but ever so fresh with a long finish.	6.70	5.10

50. <b>Merlot - Le Charme, France</b> Ripe rich plum and damson fruit, soft and very moreish.	6.35	4.75
57. <b>Rioja Vega Tempranillo - Rioja Vega, Spain</b> No oak aging with this Rioja, just 100% pure Tempranillo fresh fruity flavours. Very Moreish.	7.10	5.35
60. <b>Pinot Noir - Kuki, New Zealand</b> Aromas of red berry, cherry spice with slight savoury notes. The palate shows bright cherry and brambly berry with firm tannins giving succulent length and suppleness.	10.35	7.80
61. <b>Springhill Merlot - Irvine Estate, Australia</b> On the nose there are raspberry and plum and the palate is medium-weighted with soft tannins and a chocolate edge on the finish.	8.20	6.20
64. <b>Shiraz - Monastier, France</b> A cosy, soft red with rich fruit of blackberries, delicate spice and a hint of liquorice, velvety tannins and a lovely structure. A real Frenchman with a slight down under accent!	6.70	5.10
65. <b>Château Moulin de Mallet - St Emilion, Bordeaux</b> Very often inexpensive Claret can be quite poor quality, but not this. Lovely ripe blackcurrant and plum flavoured wine.	7.35	5.55
67. <b>Primitivo Appassimento Carlomagno - Puglia, Italy</b> The nose is complex with aromas of over-ripe cherries, raspberries, redcurrants, spices and chocolate.	7.35	5.55
70. <b>Malbec 'Lunta' - Mendel, Argentina</b> Fabulous rich powerful blackcurrant and raspberry flavours with a touch of toasty vanilla – soft velvety tannins on the finish. Quite delicious!	9.35	7.10
